Tour description:

For the first time we organize our Hungary tour as IFMR member. The center of the tour will be near Budapest, but we will visit the most beautiful parts of the country, such as the area around Lake Balaton, Eger, Mátra, and the area of the Danube and Tisza rivers.

Every morning there is a briefing by the organizers with an introduction to the Road Captain and the two Charlies for the driving day and a discussion of the stopping points.

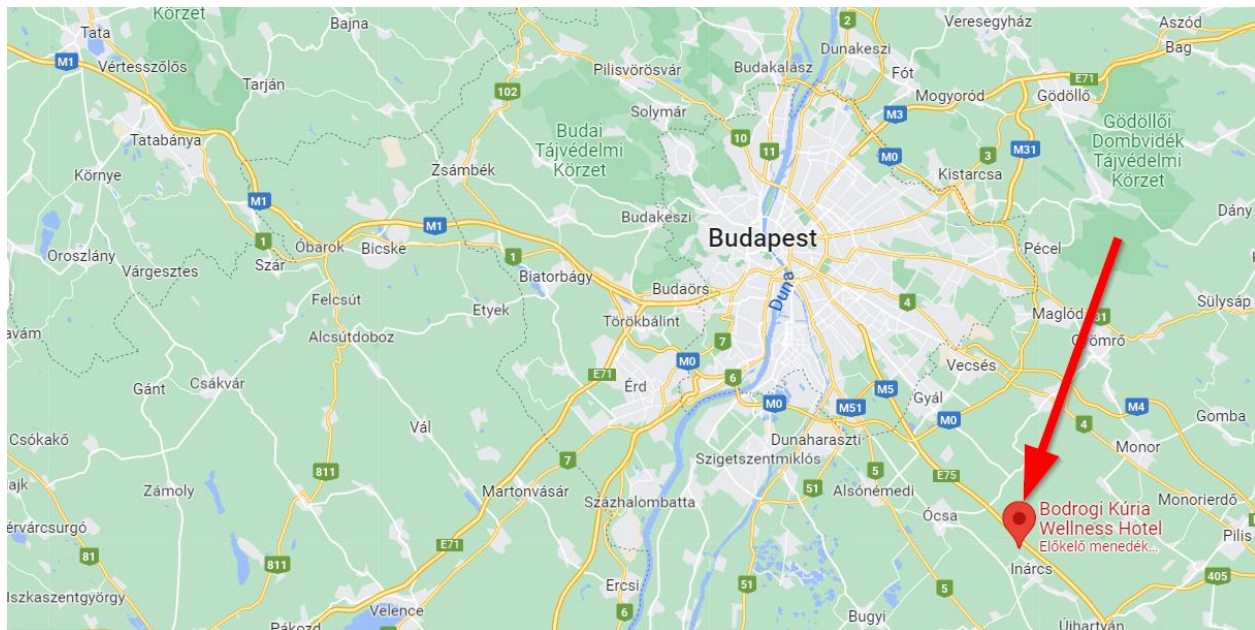

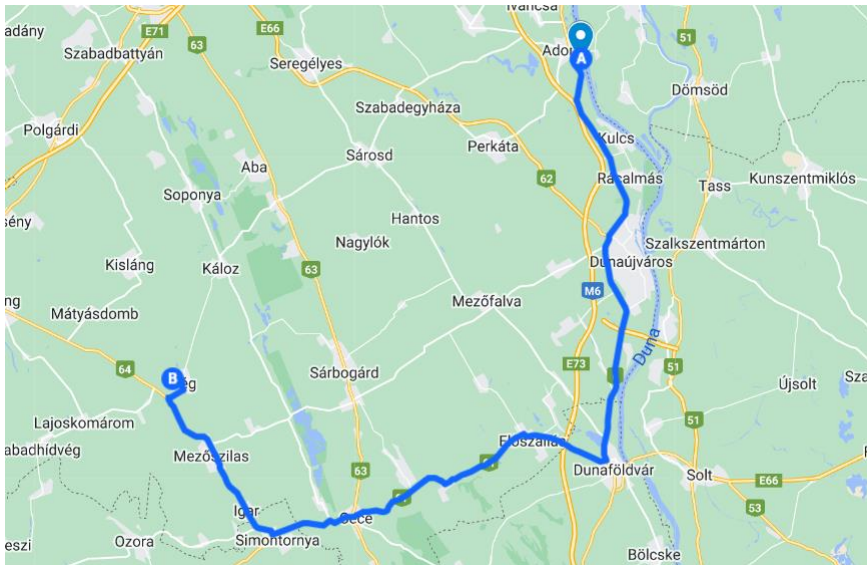

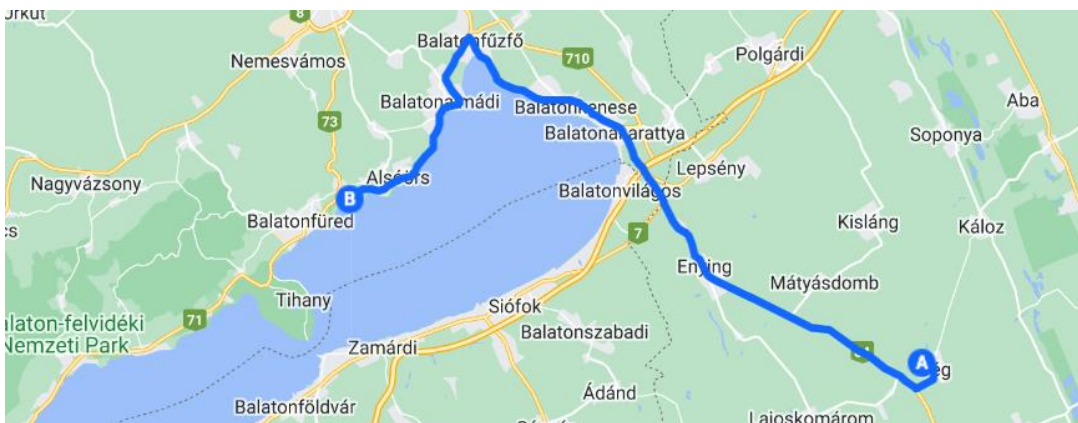
Inarcs - Adony



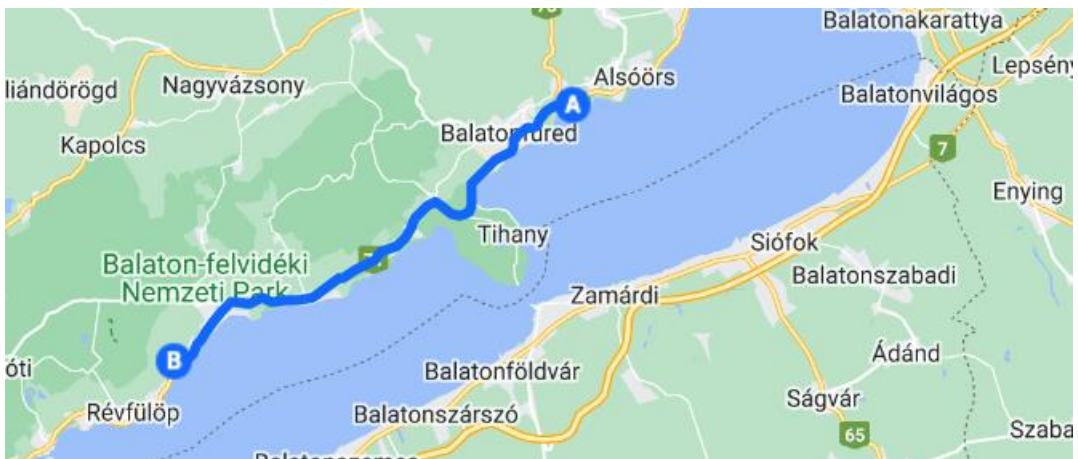
Adony - Dég

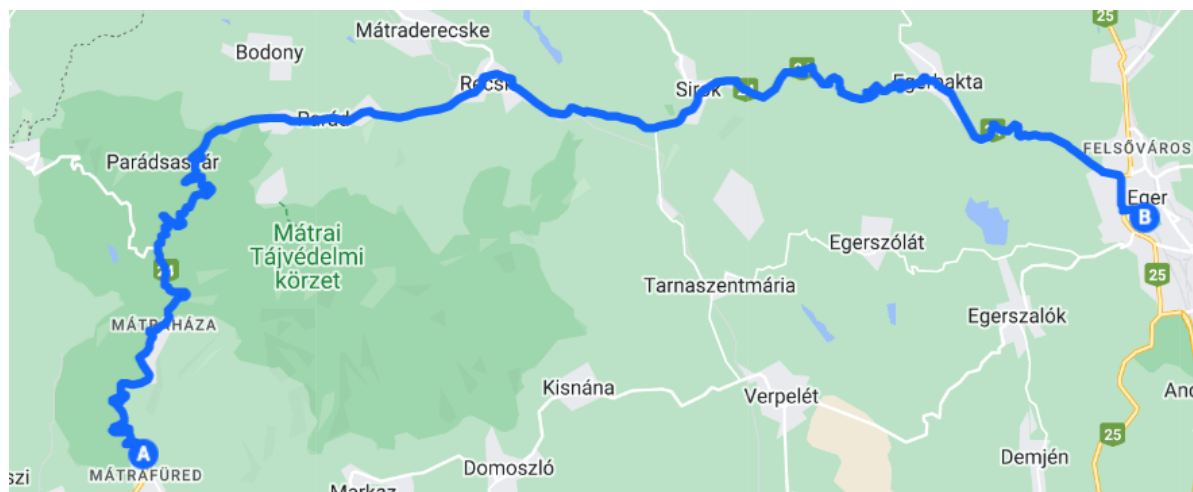
Inárcs - Jászfényszaru

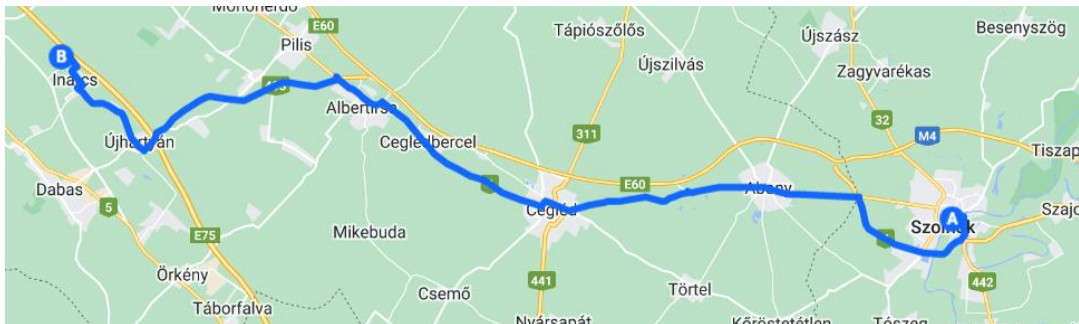
Eger - Tiszafüred

Important rules & information

getting there

For those arriving with a bike in the car or bike on a trailer, there is the possibility to park the car at the end point in Bodrogi Kúria **** Wellness Hotel, 2365 Inárcs, Tel: +36 29 371 646.

Documents

A valid identity card or passport must be carried when crossing the border!

It is recommended to take the IVK - International Insurance Card (formerly Green Card) and a European accident report with you (available from your insurance company). It may also be necessary to have a foreign health insurance certificate (or e-card).

motorway vignette

Hungary - online at <https://ematrix.nemzetiudij.hu/> When buying online, some other sellers may charge 200 forints (about 70 cents).

Attention: When paying for the e-vignette in Hungary, errors often occur when entering the license plate number or the country code - with the result of considerable additional toll charges.

Category D1M applies to motorcycles (1 week – 10 days): 1,600.- HUF (approx. 4€) Valid from the starting day specified by the buyer and another 9 days, i.e. a total of 10 consecutive calendar days, until midnight on the 10th day.

safety vests

For our safety, the motorcycle group is marked with uniform yellow warning vests. The beginning (Road Captain) and end of the group (Charlie) are marked with orange warning vests.

driving times

The travel times and route kilometers are in the overview below. There is a break of 30 minutes approximately every 1 ½ hours and a break of 1 ½ hours at midday.

Broke down motorcycle

In Hungary, the supply of spare parts and repair options is guaranteed. We urgently ask you to check and ensure the fitness of the bike before departure. Please check the condition of the bike after the daily sections (oil level, tires, chain).

In the event of a motorcycle breakdown, we will find a service within a radius of 100-150 km and we will also ensure that the motorcycle is delivered to the service quickly.

Securing motorcycles

We have arranged a monitored car park with all hotels. However, we recommend using brake locks and taking navigation devices and bags into the hotel room.

Pay

Participation fee: EUR 1,000 / room / person

Passengers: EUR 800/room together with the driver/person

Prerequisite for participation in the tour is the payment of the participation fee mentioned above. Participation is only guaranteed after receipt of payment. The places will be occupied in the order in which payment is received.

Maximum number of people 30 engines and 40 people.

The participation fee includes hotel bills, meals, meals, entrance fees, guided tours and other programs.

What everyone pays for separately is petrol, motorway vignette and all drinks (coffee, soft drinks, alcohol) and all additional consumption that is not included in the program description.

At the end of the tour, the balance of the amounts paid will be donated to charity through Rotary.

Safety Rules

orientation

Each participant should have a sufficiently accurate map of the region traveled through or GPS/mobile phone so that, if the worst comes to the worst, the destination can be found independently of the group. A navigation system can be helpful, but regardless of the navigation system's suggestions, always follow the road captain!

refueling

We start the tour every day with a full tank of fuel and do not stop to refuel during the day. There will be a gas station next to each accommodation. Refueling the motorcycle is everyone's own duty and responsibility.

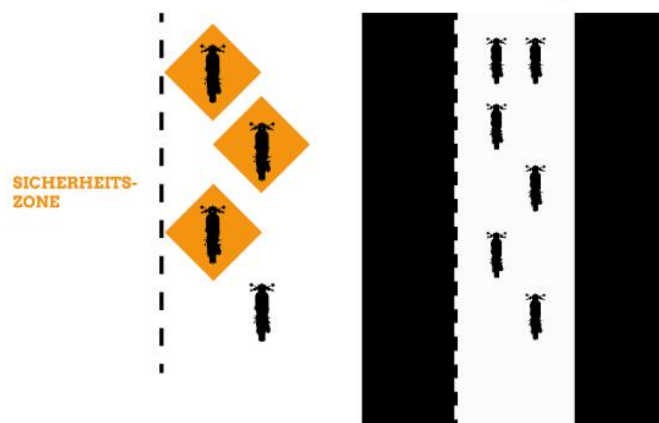
formation

Driving is according to the tried and tested safety system: the road captain drives in front with a conspicuous orange vest, everyone else falls into place behind them, with the drivers driving in a staggered manner. This is also called "zig zag". An experienced man (or woman) leads the way as a so-called "Charlie" and wears a conspicuous orange vest. He has the group members "deposited" by the Road Captain as guides cut back into the group in front of him. In addition, "Charlie" takes care of drivers who are left behind (breakdown, crash, emergency tank, etc.). Charlie remains the last driver in the group under all circumstances!

We also ask to avoid crowding, accordion and speeding.

distances

It is generally driven with normal safety distances, with the guide driving on the left and the other group members behind him "zig-zag". Only in curves are you driving one behind the other on the ideal line, the staggered driving is resumed as quickly as possible. On particularly narrow streets or passages it may also be advisable to drive one behind the other. In urban areas, especially at traffic lights, the group should be encouraged to stay together by closing up close and making a fixed start. The necessary distance to the person in front must be determined by the driver himself. The guideline must be: In the event of a mistake of the man in front or even his fall, the next man must not become the victim!



direction

At traffic lights, turnings or similar places that require directions, the guide gives the second person in the group the instruction to stop there and show everyone who follows the way. The person who is "deposited" in this way remains as a signpost until "Charlie" comes. Then he rejoins the group in front of the goalkeeper. In this way, the group "rotates" between Road Captain and Charlie, under normal circumstances everyone arrives safely at their destination.

speed

Be careful and always keep the elastic down! – We want to travel, not race...

traffic regulations

We drive on public roads, so it is important to strictly comply with the road traffic regulations. As we sometimes drive on secondary roads, watch out for children, cyclists and walkers playing, but also for free-roaming chickens, horses and other animals. Please drive very carefully, especially where you pass very close to houses.
